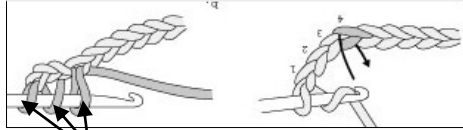
COMMON CROCHET SYMBOLS (US TERMS)

 = chain (ch)
 = slip stitch (sl st)
 or  = single crochet (sc)
 = half double crochet (hdc)
 = 3-dc cluster
 = 3-hdc cluster/puff/stubble
 = 5-dc popcorn
 = 5-dc shell
 = ch-3 picot
 = front post dc (FPdc)
 = back post dc (BPdc)
 = worked in back loop only
 = worked in front loop only

* Both symbols are commonly used for single crochet
 ** Symbol appears at base of stitch being worked



USA **double** is the same, but the count is on the hook going through **TWICE**



UK **Triple/Treble** stitch — 3 loops on needle...

USA terms tend to refer to the number of times you pull the hook through *after* picking up a stitch. UK terms tend to refer to the number of stitches on the hook just *after* picking up a stitch. (or the number of foundation chain skipped for the height) E.g.
